 - a. Summer Series

 - b. Fall training
 - MHP training offerings- Lindsey reported in-person trainings in the fall work better for them and once we have firm dates, they can determine if they are available.
 - Jennifer was going to determine if a location in Boulder is available and hasn't had a chance to determine if a location is available but will do this next week.
 - Lindsey will reach out regarding Domestic Violence trainings.
 - Lindsay will see about a Krav Maga class.
 - Kyle/Victoria-Discuss CPAT-R
 - Lindsey asked that everyone talk to their management to see if

there are any jurisdictions that would like to present.

7. CPAT-R training update

- a. Pilot- Lindsay and Alex provided a brief update on the CPAT-R Modules.
- b. CLE- Lindsay explained we need to decide if we want to decide to apply for the Ethical CLE or Standard CLE. Discussed cost and Lindsey will request information from Kyle/Victoria to discuss Ethical CLE Application. Alex will determine how much it typically costs for an Attorney to attend the course for a CLE credit.

9. Board member roundtable; including any updates to COVID/CPAT-R

- a. Denver- Removed mask requirement in offices, working a hybrid schedule and will re-evaluate that schedule in September. Reevaluating case assignments and workloads. No update to provide currently on CPAT-R. Denver is returning to in person court in August
- b. Boulder- Effective July 6th, staff have returned to the office. For the Bond Commissioners, if you aren't vaccinated you cannot interview defendants at the jail. Kindly still asking defendants to wear a mask when entering the jail. Still working a hybrid schedule for and will likely reevaluate the schedule in September. Continuing virtual intakes to slowly introduce them back in the office. Are still tentatively planning to implement CPAT-R in the fall.
- c. Larimer- Masks are not required anymore, Community Corrections and Work Release, and Jail still wear masks. Courts are open full-time and no longer doing WebEx. The CPAT-R was uploaded into LOIS and now waiting on the modules.
- d. Weld- Provided update on Arrest Standards, still working on CPAT-R implementation, and continuing a hybrid schedule. Reminded that we need to keep a standing agenda item for the Bylaws to be updated to reflect the manual for CPAT-R.
